Enclosed are an original and three copies of Puget Sound Energy, Inc.'s ("The Company") revised 2011 Energy Efficiency Services Exhibit 4; Measures, Incentives and Eligibility, and Energy Efficiency Services Exhibit 3, Program Descriptions, originally filed in Docket No. UE-100177 on December 1, 2010. An updated Exhibit 4 was filed with the WUTC on April 21, 2011.

The revisions are consistent with Section 10 of the Company's Annual Conservation Plan overview, which indicates that Exhibit 4 will be updated quarterly at a minimum, and the 2010 Electric Settlement Agreement. This submittal is also in keeping with the 2010 Electric Settlement Agreement (Docket No. UE-100177) condition K(5), which indicates that program details must be maintained as tariff attachments with the Commission and condition K(7)(a), which indicates that program modifications must be filed with the Commission as revisions to tariffs or as revisions to PSE's Annual Conservation Plan, as appropriate.

Since Exhibit 3's initial filing, a number of residential programs have been updated, including the HomePrint program, the addition of a new retail refrigerator market and measure revisions in the Multifamily New Construction program. The implementation of the 2009 Washington State Energy Code in January of 2011 necessitated the update of several measures in the Multifamily New Construction program. This replaces the document filed on December 1, 2010.

The above updates are also reflected in Exhibit 4. Additionally, several Business Energy Management rebates have been added, including LED Downlights, Reduced-wattage T8s and

CFLs. Hot Food Holding Cabinet incentive amounts were also adjusted in response to market conditions. Exhibit 4 replaces the document filed on April 21, 2011.

The Company provided advance copies of Exhibits 3 and 4, including draft and final versions, and a table outlining all of the measure changes that were implemented from April through June 2011, to the Conservation Resource Advisory Group (CRAG) on July 8, 2011.
