On March 24, 1998, PSE filed a petition for rehearing in Docket No. UG-920840 solely for the purpose of eliminating the final rate increase to Schedule 71 residential water heater lease rates scheduled for April 1, 1998. PSE now requests permission to withdraw that petition.

The rate increase, which was the last of five originally approved in Docket No. UG-920840 and scheduled to become effective October 1, 1997, was postponed until April 1, 1998 in Docket No. UG-971327. On March 19, 1998, in Docket No. UG-980442, PSE filed a petition requesting permission to suspend the rate increase. On March 24, 1998, PSE filed a petition for rehearing of the Fourth Supplemental Order in Docket No. UG-920840 for the sole purpose of eliminating that Order's requirement that residential natural gas water heater rental rates be increased. In its March 25, 1998 open meeting, the Commission approved the March 19, 1998 petition saying that the "tariff provision shall be suspended until the Commission considers and issues an order regarding the Company's request to reopen and rehear Docket No. UG-920840." Concurrent with this request, PSE is filing tariffs which would implement that rate increase effective January 1, 2000.
