- 1 Administrative Law Judge Adam E. Torem entered Order 06, *Initial Order Granting in Part Public Counsel’s Motion Requesting Official Notice of Portions of Record in Docket UE-090134 Regarding Lancaster PPA*, in this docket on June 11, 2010.
- 2 No party petitioned for administrative review of the initial order within the time for filing petitions for administrative review or received an extension of time to file such a petition. The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) did not give notice of its intention to review the order on its own motion.
- 3 Therefore, under RCW 80.01.060(3), the order on an interim procedural matter became final on July 2, 2010, by operation of law. This notice indicates the finality of that interim order, not the finality of the proceeding.
- 4 In allowing this order to become final, the Commission does not endorse the order’s reasoning and conclusions. If cited in the future, the order must be identified as an Administrative Law Judge’s order.
