1 Plaintiff's claim is stated in the written complaint, a copy of which is served upon you with this
2 summons.

3 In order to defend against this lawsuit, you must respond to the complaint by stating
4 your defense in writing, and by serving a copy upon the undersigned attorney within 20 days
5 after the service of this summons, excluding the day of service, or a default judgment may be
6 entered against you without notice. A default judgment is one where plaintiff is entitled to
7 what it asks for because you have not responded. If you serve a notice of appearance on the
8 undersigned attorney, you are entitled to notice before a default judgment may be entered.

9 You may demand that the plaintiff file this lawsuit with the court. If you do so, the
10 demand must be in writing and must be served upon the undersigned attorney. Within 14 days
11 after you serve the demand, the plaintiff must file this lawsuit with the court, or the service on
12 you of this summons and complaint will be void.

13 If you wish to seek the advice of an attorney in this matter, you should do so promptly
14 so that your written response, if any, may be served on time.

15 This summons is issued pursuant to Rule 4 of the Superior Court Civil Rules of the
16 State of Washington.
