Mr. Lauver:

You posed the following question in your March 15 letter:

“Given the definition of auto transportation and door to door in WAC along with the historical and current uses of the terms and the lack of the term “scheduled” in any other certificate issued by the commission for scheduled passenger service, how does this change apply to our situation? The phrase “Passenger service between.....” is used on every other certificate that offers scheduled services as does ours.

You are correct, most certificate use the phrase “Passenger Service between...” but when it ends in door-to-door, it is limited to just door-to-door. Our rules and practices on this point could be clearer, as could the wording in the certificates of other companies. We are considering how to clarify both in the future.

In the meantime, if you follow the steps outlined in Steven King’s March 13 letter, we will be in a position to help you clear this up at the earliest possible opportunity.
