Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on November 13, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued Order 02 in the referenced docket imposing penalties in the amount of \$5,000 on Bens Moving & Delivery Services, Inc. On November 20, 2018, a payment was made in the amount of \$346.05, leaving a balance due of \$4,653.95. On January 16, 2019, a Final Notice was sent to Bens Moving & Delivery Services, Inc. To date, the Commission has not received the remaining balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$4,653.95 balance.
