TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 12, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 02, Stipulated Initial Order Classifying Respondent as Charter Party or Excursion Service Carrier; Ordering Respondent to Cease and Desist; Imposing and Suspending Penalties on Condition of Future Compliance (Order 02) against A-Star Limousine LLC (A-Star Limousine or Company). Order 02 imposed a penalty of \$10,000 against A-Star Limousine, \$9,000 of which was suspended for two years, to be waived thereafter, subject to the conditions that: a) A-Star Limousine refrain from operating as a charter party or excursion carrier in Washington without first obtaining the required certificate, and b) the Company pay the \$1,000 portion of the penalty that was not suspended according to the approved payment schedule.

On February 25, 2021, Staff filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company had timely paid the \$1,000 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and that Staff believes the Company has refrained from operating as a charter party or excursion service carrier without a certificate. Staff recommends the suspended penalty be waived.

The Commission finds that A-Star Limousine has complied with the conditions of Order 02. The \$9,000 portion of the penalty that was suspended is now waived, and this docket is closed.
