I respectfully request that the court reconsider the revocation order due to the changes made to my Safety Management Plan where it was accepted by the UTC Transportation Safety Division members. I had no intention to make any violations to the rules, as my business license is essential for my livelihood, and I am willing to commit to fulfilling all legal requirements to maintain it.
