Dear Mr. Rayl:

As you are aware, on September 13, 2022, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Tetris Moving Company in the amount of \$3,500 for violations of the Commission's laws and rules. On October 21, 2022, the Commission entered Order 01 imposing and suspending penalties. On December 7, 2022, a Final Notice was sent to Tetris Moving Company in the amount of \$2,000, which was due on receipt. To date, the Commission has not received the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You will likely incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees and interest, which will be added to the outstanding \$2,000 balance.
