PacifiCorp and The Energy Project's Joint Request for Extension of Time to  
file a Proposal for Pacific Power's Low Income Weatherization Program**

Dear Mr. Danner,

PacifiCorp d.b.a. Pacific Power ("Company") and The Energy Project jointly request an extension of time in which to file a proposal for the Company's low income weatherization program in accordance with paragraph 20 of the stipulated settlement, dated August 1, 2008, filed in Docket UE-080220.

Order 05, Docket UE-080220, approved a stipulated settlement agreement that, among other things, required the Company to schedule a meeting by October 15, 2008 with members of the Low Income and Demand-Side Management Advisory Groups to discuss the Company's low income weatherization program. *See* Settlement Stipulation, para. 20. The stipulated settlement further requires the Company to initiate a proceeding by November 15, 2008, with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") regarding the Company's low income weatherization program.

On October 7, 2008, the Company and The Energy Project gave a joint presentation to the members of the Low Income and Demand-Side Management Advisory Groups ("Advisory Group"). Based on the recommendations from the Advisory Group, the Company worked with the low income agencies to gather the information needed for a consultant to provide analysis on the cost-effectiveness of the funding scenarios identified at the October 7, 2008 meeting. Compiling data for the scenarios took longer than anticipated and resulted in a delay in distributing the report to the members of the Advisory Group. The Company and The Energy Project believe it is important for the members of the Advisory Group to have adequate time to thoroughly review the consultant's report and develop a consensus recommendation before the Company makes the required filing with the Commission. To do this will require additional time beyond

the November 15, 2008 agreed to filing date. The Company expects to be able to make the required filing by December 5, 2008. The Company has consulted with the parties to the Settlement Stipulation filed in Docket UE-080220 including The Energy Project, Commission Staff, Public Counsel Section of the Office of the Attorney General, and Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities and no party objects to this request.

For these reasons, PacifiCorp and The Energy Project respectfully request an extension of time in which to initiate a filing regarding its low income weatherization program until December 5, 2008.


