PSE DATA REQUEST NO. 006 TO ICNU:

Mr. Mullins' testimony at page 12, lines 3 through 10, refers to the early shut down of the Trojan electric plant. Does Mr. Mullin's know if the 2011 estimated retirement date for Trojan was the life span for the plant utilized in its original prudency analysis? Please provide any and all information in your possession relating to the original prudency analysis and the decision to retire the plant earlier than 2011.

RESPONSE TO PSE DATA REQUEST NO. 006:

Mr. Mullins relied on the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's initial license, which was set to expire on February 8, 2011. 40 Fed. Reg. 55723 (Dec. 1, 1975). Additionally, Mr. Mullins considered the Oregon Public Utility Commission's decision to assess allocation of Trojan costs on a net benefits basis, which also references 2011 as the "originally scheduled closure." In the Matter of the Revised Tariff Schedules for Electric Service in Oregon filed by Portland General Electric Company, Or. P.U.C. Docket No. UE 88, Order No. 95-322 at 1-2 (Mar. 29, 1995).
