OPPORTUNITY TO SUBMIT WRITTEN COMMENTS ON PROPOSED RULES

RE: Remote Control Locomotive (RCL) Operations Rulemaking Docket No. TR-021465

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

This letter is to inform you of the progress made toward rulemaking relating to remote control locomotive (RCL) operations, and provides notice of an opportunity to file written comments on the proposed rules and participate in the formal rule adoption hearing.

At the Commission's January 28, 2004, open meeting, the Commission considered alternative proposals for amendments to WAC 480-62-320. One proposal included two subsections that addressed protection of the point of movement of remote-controlled trains at grade crossings and where trains can enter mainline tracks. The alternative proposal limited amendments to WAC 480-62-320 to clarifying and amending reporting requirements, adding definitions to WAC 480-62-125, and proceeding with a new rulemaking docket to address point protection issues generally. Since that meeting, the Commission has chosen to proceed with the alternative proposal, limited amendments to WAC 480-62-320 and WAC 480-62-125, and initiating a new rulemaking addressing point protection issues generally.

On February 18, 2004, the Commission filed a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (CR-102) in this docket with the Code Reviser. This action begins the final part of the rulemaking process, which includes a written comment period, a public adoption hearing, and a decision by the Commission.
