3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Numerous members of ICNU are customers of Avista.

4. ICNU's member companies have a substantial interest in the impacts of the sale of Avista Corporation's ("Avista") interest in the Coal-Fired Centralia Power Plant to TECWA Power, Inc., which could effect the rates and quality of service that Avista provides to ICNU's members.

5. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be effected by any Commission determination made in connection with these proceedings. It is in the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding. ICNU, therefore, requests that the Commission grant its Petition to Intervene and make ICNU a party to this proceeding
