I am a long time customer of Puget Sound Energy. I am also a resident of the state of Washington and a former shareholder in Puget Sound Energy. It has come to my attention that PSE will be presenting a 20-year energy plan in March.

While I am encouraged that PSE will be discontinuing two of its coal plants, I am disheartened that PSE is not moving aggressively to distance itself from all fossil fuel sources, specifically the two remaining coal plants and the proposed new gas plant.

Our state is already seeing the results of climate change and present CO2 levels are unacceptably high. We must move aggressively into a future without harmful carbon emissions, using conservation and increasingly inexpensive renewable energy sources, such as wind and solar.

Tell PSE their plan for the future is not adequate and must be revised with 100% carbon-free goals.
