BACKGROUND

- 1 On August 22, 2000, the Commission entered the Fifth Supplemental Order in consolidated Docket Nos. UE-991255, UE-991262, and UE-991409 approving a Stipulation that establishes a Centralia Transaction Credit ("Credit") for Puget Sound Energy, Inc., ("PSE") and authorizing PSE to file certain tariff revisions to implement payment of the Credit. On August 29, 2000, PSE filed with the Commission certain tariff revisions purporting to comply with the Commission's Order.
  
- 2 The Commission finds that the tariff revisions filed by PSE on August 29, 2000, comply with the Commission's Fifth Supplemental Order in Docket Nos. UE-991255, UE-991262, and UE-991409, and that the tariff revisions should be approved and become effective as filed.

ORDER

- 3 The Commission orders that the tariff revisions filed August 29, 2000, by PSE in accordance with the Fifth Supplemental Order in this consolidated proceeding, which are attached and by this reference made a part of this Order as though fully set forth herein, shall become effective as filed.
- 4 The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and over PSE to effectuate the provisions of this Order.
