Attached is the CenturyTel Service Quality Report d/b/a CenturyLink for the month of October, 2014. The trouble reports per 100 access lines objective was met for the month of October with the exceptions of Odessa at 15.4, Orting at 4.2, Raymond at 4.6, Vashon at 6.4 and Winthrop at 4.4. These exchanges were adversely impacted by inclement weather. Washington received 5.6 inches of rain in October as compared to less than 2 inches in August and September.
