3. All Profit and Loss Statements and Balance Sheets for Pacific Cruises Northwest, Inc. between January 1, 1999, and July 1, 2004
 4. Identification of operating vessels for which use or operations are shared with any other entity, and contracts or arrangements for such shared operations
 5. All leases and/or purchase and sale agreements for operating vessels
 6. Identification of all corporate officers, directors and shareholders, and copies of corporate minutes between January 1, 1999, and July 1, 2004
 7. Identification of any and all public revenue sources
 8. Pro forma excluding unregulated revenues
 9. Copies of communications to and from the Commission regarding suspension of services

7. Identification of all corporate officers, directors and shareholders, and copies of corporate minutes between January 1, 1999, and July 1, 2004.


Although this summarizes the information sought at this time, we reserve the right to request leave for further exchanges, pending responses to the above requests.
