NOTICE CANCELLING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

**NOTICE ESTABLISHING DATE FOR PETITIONS TO INTERVENE
(Due by January 11, 2008)**

RE: *Seatac Shuttle LLC v. Kenmore Air Harbor LLC*, Docket TC-072180

TO ALL PARTIES:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) gave notice on December 13, 2007, that it would convene a prehearing conference in this proceeding on January 10, 2008. On December 21, 2007, Commission Staff filed its Motion for Summary Determination.

On January 3, 2008, counsel for Commission Staff filed a letter with the Commission outlining agreed procedures proposed by the parties, as follows:

1. SeaTac Shuttle will hold its response to Kenmore Air's Answer until the Commission rules on Staff's motion.
2. Kenmore Air will file its response to Staff's motion on January 10, 2008.
3. SeaTac Shuttle will file its response to Staff's motion and Kenmore Air's response on January 17, 2008.
4. Should the Commission deny Staff's motion after consideration, SeaTac will then, within 20 days of the order denying the motion, file its response to Kenmore Air's Answer, and the Commission would set a date for a new pre-hearing conference to schedule the remainder of the case.

Staff's letter additionally suggests conducting the previously noticed prehearing conference via teleconference for the purpose of taking appearances and interventions.

The dates set forth in Staff's letter for responses to Staff's motion and the time interval for SeaTac Shuttle's response to Kenmore Air's Answer, if necessary, are reasonable and will be adopted. Given that Staff's motion will resolve the issues in this proceeding if granted by the Commission, and considering the expense to parties and the Commission of conducting a prehearing conference for the limited purposes it would serve in this instance, it is appropriate to cancel the previously scheduled prehearing conference. However, it is also appropriate that any person who seeks leave to intervene in this proceeding do so by petition filed within five (5) business days after the date of this notice, in the approximate time frame previously established by the Commission's notice of prehearing conference.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that the previously scheduled prehearing conference, set for January 10, 2008, is cancelled. The Commission will establish a date for a prehearing conference, if necessary, by further notice. The Commission adopts the dates proposed by the parties for the filings discussed above.

THE COMMISSION GIVES FURTHER NOTICE that any petitions to intervene in this proceeding must be filed by January 11, 2008, in order to be considered timely.
