- NATURE OF PROCEEDING. Docket UT-0730342 involves a petition by TSS Digital Services, Inc. (TSS Digital) for enforcement of its interconnection agreement with Qwest Corporation (Qwest) under WAC 480-07-650. Specifically, TSS Digital seeks enforcement of provisions of the agreement that address billing disputes and that require Qwest to work with TSS Digital to identify facilities in non-impaired wire centers that would be converted to tariffed offerings.
- 2 **CONFERENCE.** The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) convened a prehearing conference in this docket at Olympia, Washington, on August 23, 2007, before Administrative Law Judge Ann E. Rendahl.
- APPEARANCES. Judith A. Endejan, Graham & Dunn, PC, Seattle, Washington, represents TSS Digital. Lisa A. Anderl, Associate General Counsel, Seattle, Washington, represents Qwest. Contact information provided at the conference for the parties' representatives is attached as Appendix A to this order.
- 4 **PETITIONS FOR INTERVENTION.** No party appeared at the conference seeking to intervene.
- PROTECTIVE ORDER. The parties agreed that it is not necessary for the Commission to enter a protective order in this docket. If the parties determine a need for a protective order during the proceeding, any party may move that the Commission enter such an order under RCW 34.05.446, RCW 80.04.095, WAC

480-07-420 and WAC 480-07-423 to protect the confidentiality of proprietary information.

- **DISCOVERY.** The parties agreed that there is no need for discovery in this proceeding. If parties see a need for discovery, any party may move that the Commission invoke the Commission's discovery rules, WAC 480-07-400 425.
- ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION. The parties requested during the conference that the Commission assist the parties in informally resolving their dispute through mediation. Under WAC 480-07-710, the Commission assigns Administrative Law Judge Dennis Moss as a mediator in this proceeding. The parties agreed to the following schedule for mediation:

- NOTICE OF MEDIATION. The Commission has scheduled mediation in this matter, to commence on Monday, September 24, 2007, at 9:30 a.m., in Room 207 of the Commission's headquarters, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington. Additional dates for mediation may be scheduled, as needed, and will be determined by the parties and Judge Moss during the mediation process.
- 9 **PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE.** The parties agreed during the conference to defer establishing a procedural schedule in this proceeding, pending the outcome of the parties' mediation efforts.
- 10 **DOCUMENT PREPARATION AND FILING REQUIREMENTS.** Parties must file an original plus **three** (3) **paper copies** of all pleadings, motions, briefs, and other prefiled materials. These materials must conform to the format and publication guidelines in WAC 480-07-395 and WAC 480-07-460. The Commission prefers that materials be three-hole punched with *oversized* holes to allow easy handling. The

Commission may require a party to refile any document that fails to conform to these standards.

- All filings must be mailed or delivered to the Executive Secretary, Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, P.O. Box 47250, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive, S.W. Olympia, Washington 98504-7250. Both the post office box and street address are required to expedite deliveries by the U.S. Postal Service.
- An electronic copy of all filings must be provided either through the Commission's Web Portal (<a href="www.utc.wa.gov/e-filing">www.utc.wa.gov/e-filing</a>) or by e-mail delivery to <a href="mailto:records@utc.wa.gov">records@utc.wa.gov</a>. Alternatively, parties may furnish an electronic copy by delivering with each filing a 3.5-inch IBM-formatted high-density diskette or CD including the filed document(s). Parties must furnish electronic copies in MS Word 6.0 (or later) supplemented by a separate file in .pdf (Adobe Acrobat) format. Parties must follow WAC 480-07-140(5) in organizing and identifying electronic files.
- 13 **ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS.** If, at any time during this proceeding, parties are authorized to submit documents with the Commission electronically under WAC 480-07-145(6), parties must submit the document through the Commission's Web Portal (www.wutc.wa.gov/e-filing) or by e-mail to <a href="mailto:records@utc.wa.gov">records@utc.wa.gov</a>, and file an original, plus **three** (3) copies, of the document with the Commission by the following business day
- NOTICE TO PARTIES: Any objection to the provisions of this Order must be filed within ten (10) days after the service date of this Order, pursuant to WAC 480-07-430 and WAC 480-07-810. Absent such objection, this Order will control further proceedings in this matter, subject to Commission review.
