Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (“PSE”) hereby submits in connection with Docket No. UE-131585 the following substitute tariff sheets to replace the sheets substituted on March 21 and 25, 2014, in this docket. This substitute filing is pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC and includes the following portion of PSE’s WN U-60, Tariff G for electric service.

The purpose of this filing is to propose changes to the pilot incentive for electric vehicle chargers based upon the most recent Open Meeting and ongoing discussions with Commission staff. These changes include a reduced incentive payment of \$500, a 2016 sunset on the pilot and limiting participation to 5,000 customers. In addition, PSE proposes to collect metering data in order to study potential future system benefits, such as load management. The effective date on these sheets has been revised to May 1, 2014. Please also see revised enclosed workpaper. This substitution is provided for in WAC 480-80-111(a) as it does not make any material change to the pending tariff sheets.
