- 1 Defendant Rickey Clasablanca d/b/a Right Choice Movers is directed to comply
2 with Commission Order 02, a Final Order effective October 8, 2013, issued to
3 defendant Rickey Clasablanca d/b/a Right Choice Movers in Commission
4 Docket TV-131599, by immediately ceasing and desisting from engaging in
5 business as a household goods carrier in Washington State without first
6 obtaining from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission the
7 permit required under RCW 81.80.075.
8
- 9 2. Defendant Rickey Clasablanca d/b/a Right Choice Movers and all successors,
10 assigns, and transferees are hereby enjoined and permanently restrained from
11 directly or indirectly engaging in any of the following conduct:
12
- 13 a. Engaging in business as a household goods carrier by transporting
14 household goods for compensation, by motor vehicle between points in
15 Washington state, without first obtaining a household goods common
16 carrier permit from the Washington Utilities and Transportation
17 Commission.

- 19 b. Engaging in business as a household goods carrier by advertising,
20 soliciting, offering, or entering into an agreement to transport household
21 goods, without first obtaining a household goods common carrier permit
22 from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.
- 23 3. Defendant Rickey Clasablanca d/b/a Right Choice Movers is directed to pay a
24 civil penalty of \$20,000 for engaging in business as a household goods carrier
25 without first obtaining from the Washington Utilities and Transportation
26

1 Commission a household goods common carrier permit required under RCW
2 81.80.075 in violation of a cease and desist order issued by the Washington
3 Utilities and Transportation Commission under RCW 81.04.510.

4 4. Plaintiffs are awarded costs and fees and other disbursements associated with
5 the filing and maintenance of this petition for enforcement, including reasonable
6 attorneys' fees, in the amount of \$520.

7
8 5. The Court retains jurisdiction to enforce this Order.
