Dear Mr. King:

On March 24, 2016, the Commission granted Puget Sound Energy's ("PSE's") Amended Accounting Petition ("Petition") in the above-referenced dockets. PSE's fee-free payment program for its residential and small-business customers, including customers who pay with a credit or debit card, was implemented on August 25, 2016.

Paragraph 26 of the Petition granted by Order 01 in this proceeding requires PSE to provide updates to the Commission every three months after the program is implemented on the deferred balance, participation rates, and fees incurred by month.

PSE's fourth fee-free payment program update is attached and includes the required information including participation rates, fees incurred and the cumulative deferral balance which as approved by the Order is accruing to FERC account 182.3-Other regulatory assets. The update also includes additional information that is not required, but ultimately helpful in increasing understanding of PSE's fee-free payment program including average costs per transaction and total number of payments per month.
