Dear Mr. Wick:


As you are aware, on January 25, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued Order 02 Default Order Assessing Penalties against Lifters Moving in the amount of \$5,000 for violations of RCW 81.80.075, by offering to transport household goods within the state of Washington, and by advertising household goods moving services within the state of Washington. As of January 25, 2017, Lifters Moving did not pay the penalty imposed by the Commission. The Commission sent Lifters Moving a Final Notice dated March 8, 2017, indicating that the balance of \$5,000 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$5,000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$5,000 balance.
