Dear Mr. Johnson:

On November 14, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 02, which assessed Leavenworth Party Bus, LLC, d/b/a Leavenworth Party Bus (Leavenworth Party Bus or Company) a penalty of \$10,000 for operating as a charter or excursion carrier after the cancellation of its certificate. Order 02 further suspended a \$9,000 portion of the penalty for a period of two years on the conditions that: (1) the Company refrains permanently from further operations as a charter or excursion carrier in the state of Washington without first obtaining the required certificate, and (2) Leavenworth Party Bus pays the \$1,000 portion of the penalty that is not suspended.

On November 19, 2018, the Company paid the \$1,000 penalty in full. To date, Leavenworth Party Bus has refrained permanently from further operations as a charter or excursion carrier in this state. Staff finds that Leavenworth Party Bus satisfied the conditions of Order 02 and recommends that the \$9,000 suspended penalty be waived.
