NOTICE SUSPENDING PAYMENT PLAN (Next Installment Payment due by 5 p.m. on October 7, 2020)

RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment against Iron Man Movers and Storage, Inc., in the amount of \$6,100, Docket TV-190694

TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 6, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment (Penalty Assessment) against Iron Man Movers and Storage, Inc., (Iron Man Movers or Company) in the amount of \$6,100 for 61 violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15-570. On September 23, 2019, the Commission entered Order 01, Granting Payment Arrangement (Order 01). Among other provisions, Order 01 approved a payment plan that permitted Iron Man Movers to pay the \$6,100 penalty in 12 monthly installments, the first of which was due on October 7, 2019. To date, Iron Man Movers has made six timely payments and is in good standing.

Due to the economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Commission exercises its discretion to suspend the Company's payment plan for a period of six months. Accordingly, the remaining installments are due as follows:
