TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND PARTIES:

On July 15, 2020, Murrey's Disposal Company, Inc. (Murrey's Disposal or Company), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a complaint against Waste Management of Washington, Inc. (WMW), Waste Management Disposal Services of Oregon, Inc. (WMDSO), and MJ Trucking & Contracting, Inc. (MJ Trucking) (collectively, Respondents), asking the Commission to order WMW, WMDSO, and MJ Trucking to cease and desist from engaging in the collection and transportation of solid waste without a certificate of authority from the Commission and to find that certain intermodal motor carrier transportation services offered by WMW or WMDSO are not preempted by 49 C.F.R. § 1090.2.

On August 4, 2020, Respondents filed with the Commission Answers to the Complaint and a Motion to Dismiss pursuant to WAC 480-07-380(1).

The Commission may set a deadline for any responses to a motion to dismiss pursuant to WAC 480-07-380. Accordingly, the Commission requires the filing of any responses to Respondents' Motion to Dismiss by 5 p.m. on Thursday, August 20, 2020.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That any party intending to file a response to Respondents' Motion to Dismiss must file a written response by August 20, 2020.
