Dear Mr. M. Gavin McCarty:

A review of Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) records indicates that you have not remitted payment for the enclosed Notice of Penalties dated July 5, 2006.

On September 13, 2006, Globalcom, Inc. filed a petition for mitigation and waived a hearing. On October 6, 2006, the commission issued an order denying mitigation (enclosed). At this time, commission records indicate the penalty assessment remains outstanding.

If we do not receive your \$100 payment by July 18, 2007, the commission will consider additional sanctions. In addition, we will refer the matter to the Office of the Attorney General for collection.
