TRACER submits the following response to Judge Berg's instruction in the Second Supplemental Order that parties file written comments identifying the rates that should be reviewed in this docket. Judge Berg has authorized the parties to file these comments by facsimile today and by overnight mail for filing tomorrow.

TRACER concurs in the comments filed by WorldCom and concurred in by AT&T and XO proposing that the Commission review recurring and non recurring rates for loops, switching, and shared transport.

TRACER also agrees with WorldCom, AT&T and XO that the costing methodology used for loops should be consistent across all loop types, including high capacity loops. Accordingly, TRACER submits that the cost models that will be presented by the parties should be capable of developing costs for all loops.
