- On October 22, 2003, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Penalty Assessment No. UW-031596 against Virgil R. Fox, President, American Water Resources, Inc. (American Water) in the amount of \$3,700 for failure to deposit amounts required for June 2002, July 2002, August 2002, September 2002, October, 2002, November 2002, and for unauthorized use of funds for June 2003.
- 2 On November 6, 2003, American Water filed with the Commission an Application for Mitigation of Penalties, asking that the penalty be reduced.
- On December 9, 2003, Commission Staff filed a Response to the Application for Mitigation of Penalties and a Motion Requesting Adjudication. Commission Staff requests the application for mitigation be denied and that the Commission commence an adjudication regarding this matter pursuant to RCW 80.04.405. Commission Staff mentions that the Commission may use a brief adjudicative proceeding to resolve a petition for mitigation of penalty assessment under WAC 480-09-500(1)(e).
- 4 Hearing in this matter is being held pursuant to Part IV of chapter 34.05 RCW pertaining to adjudicative proceedings, including but not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW 34.05.452. Statutes involved, in addition to those previously cited, include those within chapter 80.01 RCW, chapter 80.04 RCW, and chapter 80.28 RCW, including but not limited to RCW 80.01.040, RCW 80.04.380, RCW 80.04.385, RCW 80.04.390, and RCW 80.04.405. Rules involved include those within chapter 480-09 WAC and chapter 480-110 WAC.

- ⁵ The ultimate issues include whether the penalty should be mitigated as requested, and what actions are necessary for American Water Resources, Inc., to cure previous instances of non-compliance with state law and Commission rules and to maintain substantial future compliance, pursuant to the statutory provisions of chapter 80.04 RCW.
- 6 Although the Commission declines to conduct this proceeding as a brief adjudicative proceeding under WAC 480-09-500, the Commission intends that the adjudication proceed efficiently and with the greatest degree of informality consistent with fairness and the nature of the proceeding. *See RCW 34.12.010.*

- 9 Petitions to intervene should be made in writing prior to the hearing date or made orally at the hearing. Appearances will be taken. If any party or witness needs an interpreter or other assistance, please fill out the form attached to this notice and return it to the Commission. The time and place for the evidentiary hearings will be set at the prehearing conference or by later written notice.
- 10 NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN THAT ANY PARTY WHO FAILS TO ATTEND OR PARTICIPATE IN THE HEARING SET BY THIS NOTICE, OR ANY OTHER STAGE OF THIS PROCEEDING, MAY BE HELD IN DEFAULT IN ACCORDANCE WITH RCW 34.05.440. THE PARTIES ARE FURTHER ADVISED THAT THE SANCTION PROVISIONS OF WAC 480-09-700(4) ARE SPECIFICALLY INVOKED.
