RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Daniel Stein, d/b/a Seabeck Waste & Recycling Commission Staff's Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalties of Order 02 Docket TG-180181

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On December 10, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 02, which assessed Daniel Stein, d/b/a Seabeck Waste & Recycling (Seabeck or Company) a penalty of \$2,000 for operating as a solid waste carrier without a certificate. Order 02 further suspended a \$1,000 portion of the penalty for a period of two years on the conditions that: (1) the Company refrains permanently from further operations as a solid waste carrier in the state of Washington without first obtaining the required certificate, and (2) Seabeck pays the \$1,000 portion of the penalty that is not suspended.

On December 24, 2018, the Company paid the \$1,000 penalty. Seabeck has refrained from operating as a solid waste carrier in this state for the period described above. For these reasons, staff finds that Seabeck satisfied the conditions of Order 02 and recommends the remaining \$1,000 suspended penalty be waived.
