As you are aware, on May 7, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Bulldog Concrete Services, LLC in the amount of \$1,000 for violations of RCW 19.122.030(2). A portion of the penalty was suspended on the condition that Bulldog Concrete pay a \$200 portion of the penalty, have its employees attend Dig Safe training, and commit no further violations. All of the conditions were not met, and the Commission sent you a Final Notice dated January 3, 2020, indicating that the balance of \$800 was due.

To date, the Commission has not received payment of the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$800 balance.
