1           In accordance with WAC 480-07-385 and the Notice Establishing Response Dates, Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power), a division of PacifiCorp, responds to The Walla Walla Country Club's Alternative Motion to Extend Filing Date for Answer.

2           The degree of respect and professionalism exhibited by counsel in this proceeding has been exceptional. As a matter of professional courtesy, there have been a number of agreed requests for extensions of time, to accommodate family health issues, vacations and other circumstances. The latest of which was a request to postpone the post-hearing briefing, to accommodate the vacation schedule of counsel for the Walla Walla Country Club. Consistent with that appreciated course of dealing, Pacific Power stipulates to the Walla Walla Country Club's request for extension of time to answer Pacific Power's Petition for Administrative Review.<sup>1</sup>

3           On its own motion, the Commission continued the date for the Walla Walla Country Club's answer to Pacific Power's Petition for Administrative Review until ten
