- Only slightly more past due customers are estimated low income compared to overall customer base (~46%)
- Only slightly more past due customers are estimated energy burdened compared to overall customer base (~16%)
- Overall, past due customers are somewhat more likely to be in HIC and High Vulnerability populations, but not any more likely to be estimated low income or energy burdened.
