RE: *Washington Utils. and Transp. Comm'n v. Puget Sound Energy*,
Dockets UE-240004, UG-240005, and UE-230810 (*Consolidated*)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 17, 2025, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 11/09 in the above-referenced docket. On March 21, 2025, the Commission issued a Notice of Clarification authorizing Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) to make a compliance filing to implement the Targeted Electrification Pilot Phase II consistent with Order 11/09 and that Notice of Clarification.

The Company was directed to separately assign and control Targeted Electrification Pilot Phase II costs of \$22.3 million (before revenue-sensitive items) and charges to customers, with \$11.7 million for electric customers, evenly allocating costs between gas and electric customers.¹

On April 7, 2025, PSE filed with the Commission its Advice No. 2025-24 and also provided supporting workpapers.

On April 11, 2025, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that Staff has reviewed the Company's compliance filing dated April 7, 2025, and believes that the filing complies with Commission Order 11/09, entered March 17, 2025, and its Notice of Clarification, entered March 21, 2025.
