Dear Ms. Washburn:

This is in regard to the SGAT Exhibit A Qwest filed on July 11, 2003. In that filing, Qwest states it had revised Exhibit A to reflect the rates ordered in Parts B and D of the cost docket, Docket No. UT-003013, which are currently in the tariff. It has come to my attention that there are two rate elements that do not match the tariff – the local switching premium port charge and the six-port conferencing charge. This is because Qwest found errors in these rates in the tariff and has now made a “clean up” filing to correct those (Advice No. 3414T, Docket No. UT-031165). The correct rates are shown in Exhibit A. Upon the effective date of the tariff filings, all of the rates in the tariff and this most recent Exhibit A will match.

This explanation is provided simply to avoid any confusion about the correct rates and to allow parties to understand why there is not currently a perfect match between the SGAT and the tariff.
