Dear Judge Howard:

The Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Co., Alliance of Western Energy Consumers, The Energy Project, and Walmart, Inc. (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Settling Parties") have reached a full multiparty settlement in principle in the docket referenced above and are notifying the Commission pursuant to WAC 480-07-740(2)(c). The Public Counsel Unit of the Washington Attorney General's Office (Public Counsel) has not joined the settlement.

The Settling Parties intend to file the settlement and supporting testimony on October 28, 2021. Public Counsel will provide an update to the Commission as to whether it will be joining the settlement on the same date. In the meantime, all parties ask the Commission to suspend the existing procedural schedule except for the public comment hearing on November 18, 2021. If the Commission believes that a hearing will assist it in deciding whether to approve or adopt the settlement, the parties request that the hearing be scheduled on December 3, 2021.
