CITY OF SEATAC'S MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME

The City of SeaTac, for its Motion for Extension of Time, states as follows:

1. The City of SeaTac requests an extension of time of one week until Monday, August 13, 2001, in which to file their Motion for Summary Adjudication. The parties have worked together diligently to agree upon a Comprehensive Issues List, Stipulation of Material Facts, and Identification of Contested Material Facts and to develop an exhibit list. During the course of these

1 discussions, it has become apparent that the fact issues are more complicated than anticipated. As a
2 result, SeaTac needs additional time to prepare its Motion for Summary Adjudication and supporting
3 materials.

4 2. For these reasons, SeaTac requests an extension of time until August 13, 2001 to file
5 its Motion for Summary Adjudication.

6 3. Counsel for Puget Sound Energy, Commission Staff, and the City of Clyde Hill have
7 indicated they do not object to this extension of time. However, the other parties request that the
8 time for filing responsive and reply briefs be extended by one week as well for all parties.

9 4. The Cities request that the procedural schedule established in the Prehearing
10 Conference Order be amended as follows:

Motions for Summary Determination	August 13, 2001
Responses to Motions	August 24, 2001
Replies to Responses	August 31, 2001
