1 On July 30, 2004, Rainier View Water Company, Inc., filed with the Commission a revision to its currently effective Tariff WN U-2, instituting a water conservation tier for all water usage over 3,000 cubic feet per month from May through September. The operation of such tariff revisions has been suspended by order of the Commission pending hearing or hearings concerning such changes and the justness and reasonableness thereof.

2 Following a prehearing conference conducted on November 29, 2004, the Commission established a hearing schedule by entry of Order No. 02. On February 7, 2005, counsel for Rainier View filed a letter requesting that the procedural schedule be “held in abeyance” in light of a pending settlement. The Commission has held this proceeding in abeyance anticipating that a settlement would be filed. As of today, no settlement has been filed. Accordingly, it is necessary for the Commission to conduct an informal status conference to determine whether a settlement is to be filed and, if so, when. In addition, there is a need to discuss scheduling for such process as is appropriate considering the status of the case.

3 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That an informal status conference in this matter will be held at 1:30 p.m., on Tuesday, March 1, 2005, in Room 108, Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S.
