4. WeBTEC is an association of large end-users of communications services. Its

members have facilities located in numerous locations throughout the state of Washington,

including areas served by Washington Independent Telephone Association ("WITA") member

companies. According to the Petition filed by WITA and TDS Telecom an issue in this docket

is whether a VoIP service provider, Comcast, has rights to negotiate interconnection pursuant

to 47 U.S.C. § 251 with an incumbent local exchange company ("ILEC") or whether Comcast

is acting as a telecommunications carrier offering telecommunications services subject to

WUTC regulation. WeBTEC has a substantial interest in the subject matter of this proceeding

because its members currently use VoIP services and plan to continue to use, and perhaps

expand their use of, VoIP services in the future. The resolution of the issue identified above

could have a significant impact on the availability and/or the terms of service for those VoIP

services from numerous VoIP providers. Further, any competitive constraint provided by VoIP

services on the prices and quality of traditional telecommunications services purchased by

WeBTEC members could also be negatively impacted. In short, the order eventually issued in

this docket could have a significant direct and indirect impact on the services available to

WeBTEC members to satisfy their communications needs and the prices and quality of those

services.
