NOTICE OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE REVISIONS

TO ALL PARTIES:

On October 17, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered a Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding in this matter. The Notice set 1:30 p.m. on November 8, 2012, as the time and date for parties to present oral statements in support of their positions.

On November 2, 2012, attorney Matthew J. Bellmer notified the Commission that he would be serving as representative for AA Eagle Relocation Service and would be seeking a continuance to allow him sufficient time to prepare for the hearing. On November 7, 2012, Mr. Bellmer filed a motion with the Commission asking to postpone the hearing to December 12, 2012. Commission Staff does not object to the motion.

AA Eagle Relocation Service's request for continuance is granted. The request complies with the requirements in WAC 480-07-385, and will not prejudice the parties or the Commission.
