Dear Mr. Martin:

As you are aware, on October 19, 2015, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued Order 02, Classifying Martin Movers as a Household Goods Carrier; Ordering Martin Movers to Cease & Desist; Imposing and Suspending Penalties on Condition of Future Compliance. A penalty of \$5,000 was imposed, \$4,500 of which was suspended on condition that the Company pay \$500 within 10 days of the effective date of the order. As of June 9, 2016, Martin Movers has not complied with the conditions of Order 02, in violation of RCW 81.80.075, and the full penalty amount of \$5,000 became due and payable. The Commission sent Martin Movers a Corrected Final Notice dated June 24, 2016, indicating that the balance of \$5,000 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$5,000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$5,000 balance.
