NOTICE OF CLARIFICATION OF BENCH REQUEST NO. 4

The Commission's request is for updated, functional revenue requirement models. Public Counsel's response should include an explanation in the models, or in appendix if necessary, illustrating or identifying all updates to its previously filed revenue requirement models.
