Dear Amanda Maxwell:

On March 25, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 09 Rejecting Tariff Sheets; Approving and Adopting Partial Multiparty Settlement Stipulation; Resolving Contested Issues; Authorizing and Requiring Compliance Filing (Order 09) in the above-referenced docket. Order 09, among other things, required Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities (Avista) to propose an on-bill repayment/financing program for small business and residential programs to the Energy Efficiency Advisory Group (EEAG) and, if Avista and the EEAG reach agreement on program terms and design, file the programs with the Commission.¹

On June 1, 2021, Avista filed with the Commission its tariff revision adding an On-Bill Repayment Program to Schedule 90 in UE-210399 and Schedule 190 in UG-210400.

Commission Staff (Staff) reviewed the filings provided by Avista dated June 1, 2021, and finds that it contains sufficient detail with respect to an on-bill repayment program. Therefore, Staff believes that the filing complies with the Commission's Order 09, entered March 25, 2020.
