On July 15, 2004, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) submitted by electronic mail a Motion to Compel Responses to Data Requests to Staff, requesting resolution of its motion prior to July 21, 2004, in advance of a deposition of Staff's witness scheduled for July 21-22, 2004. Qwest plans to file a paper copy of the motion with the Commission today.

**In order to resolve the pending discovery dispute expeditiously, answers to Qwest's motion to compel must be filed with the Commission by 3:00 p.m. on Monday, July 19, 2004.** Parties may submit answers electronically pursuant to WAC 480-07-145(6). A hearing to present arguments on the motion, including an oral reply by Qwest to any answers filed, will be held on **Tuesday, July 20, 2004, beginning at 9:00 a.m. in Room 108 of the Commission's Offices located in the Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.** Persons who cannot attend the conference in person may participate via the Commission's teleconference bridge line 360-664-3846.
