## TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 25, 2020, the Commission entered its final order, Order 09, Rejecting Tariff Sheets; Approving and Adopting Partial Multiparty Settlement Stipulation; Resolving Contested Issues; and Authorizing and Requiring Compliance Filing (Order 09) in Dockets UE-190334, UG-190335, and UE-190222 (Consolidated). Order 09, among other things, required Avista to propose an on-bill repayment/financing program for small business and residential programs to the Energy Efficiency Advisory Group (EEAG) and, if Avista and the EEAG reach agreement on program terms and design, file the programs with the Commission.

On June 1, 2021, the Company filed its tariff revision adding an On-Bill Repayment Program to Schedule 90 and Schedule 190.<sup>1</sup>

On March 16, 2023, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket stating that Staff had reviewed the tariff filings and believes that the filings comply with the terms of Order 09 regarding the on-bill repayment program.

The Commission finds that the tariff revisions Avista filed with the Commission on June 1, 2021, comply with pertinent terms of Order 09.
