DATA REQUEST NO. 20:

Regarding the prefiled testimony of Kurt Thorne, Exhibit KT-1T on page 6, stating “As the person ultimately responsible for environmental compliance at the Mill, I needed the problem resolved,” produce all records relating to efforts made by Mr. Thorne directly, or at his direction or request, to determine, identify or establish a solution that would permit OCC Rejects to be sufficiently dried before being loaded by PCA in a drop box so that the same would not leak liquids onto public roads, and which solution would comply with PCA’s Title V permit.

RESPONSE:

PCA’s solution, at Mr. Thorne’s direction, to determine, identify or establish a process that would permit OCC Rejects to be sufficient dried was to have Jammie’s manage the OCC Rejects. Jammie’s developed an efficient and effective process for ensuring the OCC Rejects were sufficiently dried for hauling and to ensure compliance with PCA’s Title V permit. Aside from the records that have already been produced in this case, no additional documents responsive to this request are believed to exist.
