

Big Al's Specialty Movers Inc., HG-61724, obtained household goods permit authority under the provisions of WAC 480-15-340 upon review of an application (P079351) docketed on April 4, 2005. The principal shareholders in this Washington based corporation are Alfred and Rhonda Bartley, who are active in the day to day business operation.

The carrier was offered educational and technical assistance in all aspects of the economic and safety regulations as adopted and enforced by the Commission

On May 3, 2005, carrier officials were given a comprehensive review of the economic regulations and the principles of Tariff 15-A. Safety regulations were discussed on July 26, 2005.

Further educational and technical assistance on economic and safety issues was afforded the firm on October 10, October 20 and October 27, 2005.

An economic and safety compliance review was performed on November 17, 2005.

The firm has operated primarily as a retail store delivery general commodities carrier specializing in commercial piano and organ moves for several years. The carrier has an excellent reputation for reliability, customer service and safe operating procedures after handling nearly 2000 individual commercial or office shipments, which are not regulated under the WAC 480-15 rules, in the past two years. Customer satisfaction is high based on surveys performed by the carrier.

ECONOMIC REGULATION

The carrier has transported only three residential household goods moves in 2005. The firm has operated within the scope of the permit authority. Management is aware of annual reporting requirements.

Cargo insurance with limits of \$250,000 less deductible is underwritten by Oregon Automobile Insurance Company (Policy C01164250).

The carrier uses the proper bill of lading format for residential household goods moves. Rates and charges are within the banded Tariff 15-A rates. The company is aware of the differences in hourly and weight/distance hauls.

When an estimate is given, it is in writing and in the proper format. The carrier is aware that verbal estimates are illegal. The firm has not charged more than an estimate given to a customer.

There have been no claims or complaints. The firm is aware of the reporting and record retention requirements for loss/damage/complaints.

SAFETY REGULATIONS

The carrier has a working knowledge of the federal motor carrier safety regulations. There have been no recordable crashes in the past twelve months. Vehicles are properly marked and identified.

Driver qualification files were essentially complete with the exception of some timely background investigations on drivers. The carrier planned to update the files immediately.

The carrier generally operates within a 150 air mile radius of the principal place of business. Driver maintain a time record consisting of starting time, ending time and total on duty time. When the record of duty status format is used there were some form and manner type violations. The carrier was given additional instruction on log book content. 11-14-70 hour rules, 34 hour reset and the 16 hour exception.

Drivers perform a pre-trip inspection and have been filing a post trip inspection report. Written maintenance records are kept and due dates for service to be performed are tracked. One vehicle did not have a current annual (periodic) inspection documented

The firm operates vehicles under 26,001 gross vehicle weight rating and drivers are not currently subject to commercial driver's license or controlled substance/alcohol testing.

No commercial motor vehicles were available for inspection on the date of this survey as they were working out of the area. The carrier has not had any vehicle out of service violations. Inspections will be scheduled at a later. However, as noted above the

annual (periodic) inspections have been performed by a qualified mechanic pursuant to 49 CFR Part 396.17.

SUMMARY

Even though the carrier has transported few residential household goods shipments during the provisional period, management has a good working knowledge of the economic regulations concerning bills of lading, estimates, rates and charges, and claims management.
