promptly remedied and that there were no further violations found on service level frequency.

9 Based on the criteria set forth in the *MCI Metro* and *Waste Management of Wenatchee* cases, the Settling Parties urge the Commission to find that the proposed sanction is fully consistent with law and rule and serves the public interest.¹ Considering then the foregoing criteria, and the agency's inherent discretion to impose sanctions up to a certain range but not mandating the quantified maximum range be applied, the Settling Parties urge the Commission to exercise its statutory discretion and approve the proposed monetary settlement and, after payment thereof to the Commission, dismiss the subject complaint.

VI. CONCLUSION

10 Because the Settling Parties have negotiated a full compromise on all of the issues in this dispute, and because the settlement is in the public interest, both parties request that the Commission enter an Order approving the settlement.


