**NOTICE VACATING AND RESCHEDULING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE
(Set for May 19, 2011, at 11:00 a.m.)**

TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD:

On April 8, 2011, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered a Complaint against Maria K. Lindberg alleging 180 violations of applicable statutes and rules. On April 18, 2011, Maria K. Lindberg filed an Answer. By Notice of Prehearing Conference entered April 29, 2011, the Commission scheduled a prehearing conference to convene on May 11, 2011.

On May 10, 2011, the parties filed a letter requesting that the Commission waive a prehearing conference in this matter.

Given the minimal time between the request to waive the prehearing conference and the scheduled date and time of the conference, the Commission vacates the prehearing conference scheduled to convene on May 11, 2011. However, the joint letter filed by the parties presents a number of issues that can most efficiently and expeditiously be addressed in a prehearing conference. Accordingly, the prehearing conference will be rescheduled.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the prehearing conference in this matter scheduled to convene on May 11, 2011, at 1:30 p.m., is vacated.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a prehearing conference in this matter at 11:00 a.m., on May 19, 2011, in the Commission's Hearing Room, Second Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That any party who fails to attend or participate in the prehearing conference set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC 480-07-450.
