- 1 On July 17, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order Instituting Special Proceeding; Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; and Notice of Mandatory Appearance at Hearing (Order 01), initiating this docket on its own motion. The Complaint alleges that Transit Systems, Inc. d/b/a Moves for Seniors¹ (Moves for Seniors or Company) violated RCW 81.80.075(1) by offering and advertising household goods moving services within the state of Washington without the necessary permit required for such operations. On the same date, the Commission issued a Subpoena and Subpoena Duces Tecum For Production of Documents to the Company commanding Moves for Seniors to appear before the Commission at a special proceeding scheduled to convene at 9 a.m. on October 25, 2017, and to bring the documents specified in the subpoenas.
- 2 On October 20, 2017, contacted the Commission to contest the allegations set out in the Complaint and request a formal classification hearing. The Company appeared at the special proceeding on October 25, 2017, and reiterated its request.
- 3 Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for resolving the issues in this docket.
- 4 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 9 a.m., on Tuesday, December 19, 2017, in Room 206,**

¹ The Complaint originally named "Tara Chila d/b/a Moves for Seniors" as the Respondent in this matter. In a letter to the Commission dated October 20, 2017, the Company's attorney informed the Commission that Tara Chila was an employee of Transit Systems, Inc., and requested the Commission correct its records to accurately reflect the Company's name as Transit Systems, Inc. d/b/a Moves for Seniors.

- 5 The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.
- 6 Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The Commission will provide at its offices in Olympia, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.
- 7 Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission all proposed exhibits, as well as a list enumerating and describing them, **no later than 5 p.m. on Tuesday, December 12, 2017**, and bring an original and three (3) copies to the hearing. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140.
- 8 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the brief adjudicative proceeding set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC 480-07-450.**
